2. Attain a Higher Diploma/Associate's degree in any discipline from a recognized institute (or equivalent); and

3. Satisfy minimum entry requirements for Registered Nurse training set by the NCHK (http://www.nchk.org.hk/filemanager/en/pdf/minimum entry.pdf).
